ARTS SCHOLARSHIP – Elementary and High School

A scholarship granted to Elementary and High School Students who have demonstrated exceptional talent and accomplishment in the fields of culture and the arts, as evidenced by participation or recognition in accredited competitions, showcases, or exhibitions at the regional level or higher.

I. General Terms and Conditions

Scholars for all scholarship categories found in Ordinance No. 7SP 2026 must comply with the following terms and conditions:

- a. The Scholar must be a Filipino Citizen and City of Batac resident for at least six (6) months prior to application for scholarship.
- b. A certification from the Commission on Election (COMELEC) that parent, parents, or guardian/s are registered voters of Batac City. Once the scholar reaches the age of 15 years old, he/she must also present a COMELEC certification showing that he/she is also a registered voter of Batac.
- c. Scholars must be enrolled in a recognized educational institution.
- d. Scholarship shall be good for only (1) school year or school semester, as applicable and may be renewed as long as it is within the prescribed number of school years needed to graduate from the curriculum, degree or program and provided that conditions for renewal are met.
- e. Scholars must meet/maintain the prescribed General Weighted Average or maintaining grade per scholarship category.
- f. Multiple family members may be eligible for scholarships (except vocational/technical courses students), provided they meet the eligibility requirements.
- g. Applicants shall comply with the income documentation and family status verification requirements applicable to the scholarship category applied for.
- h. Scholars who fail to get scholarship grant for not meeting the qualifications for their chosen scholarship category shall not bar from applying in other scholarship categories.
- i. Scholars must carry the full load prescribed or allowable in the curriculum of the institution they are enrolled in.
- j. Deadlines for the application process and claiming of scholarship grants shall be set by the Office of the Mayor – Local Youth Development Section, in coordination with the City Treasurer's Office.
- k. Some scholars shall be required to render service hours or return of service. The Office of the Mayor - Local Youth Development Section together with the City Human Resource Management Office must prepare a list of Calendar of Activities for scholars and must notify the scholars of the available dates for service hours.
- l. Students who are already recipients of scholarships or any financial grants offered by any government and private institutions are no longer eligible for scholarships offered by the City Government of Batac.
- m. If the grantee fails to enroll due to disabling sickness, the continuation of his/her scholarship shall be considered on case to case basis by the Scholarship Screening Committee (SSC).
- n. If he/she is found guilty of grave misconduct or misdemeanor in accordance with existing school policies, rules and regulations, the scholarship of the grantee may be terminated by the Scholarship Screening Committee (SSC).

II. Qualifications and other requirements

Aside from the general terms and conditions, an applicant for the Arts Scholarship for Elementary and High School students must comply with the following:

1. Must be enrolled in a public or private elementary school and high school;
2. Must have participated in artistic performances, exhibits, productions, demonstrations, or cultural integration activities involving visual arts, performing arts, literary arts, media and applied arts, traditional or folk arts, and contemporary or emerging art forms, at the regional, national, or international levels within the last two (2) year, in competitions, festivals, exhibitions or showcases duly accredited by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) or other duly organized cultural authorities. Such participation must have resulted in the applicant receiving at least an award, commendation, citation, or its equivalent official recognition at the regional level or higher. Participation limited solely to school-level or intra-school activities shall not qualify. Preference shall be given to applicants who have received multiple awards, higher level distinctions, or official recognition for their artistic performance, exhibition, or cultural contribution.
3. Must have obtained a General Weighted Average (GWA) of at least eighty percent (80%) during the immediately preceding school year, with no failing grade in any subject, as reflected in the latest Report Card submitted;
4. Must be able to submit the following documents:
 - a. PSA issued birth certificate
 - b. Photocopy of latest Student's Report Card;
 - c. Certification of Good Moral Character from the school where he/she came from;
 - d. Proof of residency from the Barangay Captain where he/she resides in;
 - e. Medical Certificate from a licensed Physician;
 - f. Certification of participation/award issued Department of Education (DepEd), National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), or a duly recognized cultural or school authority, clearly confirming that the applicant achieved at least a podium finish (placer) or its equivalent recognition at the regional level or higher.

III. Maintaining grade and other conditions to continue availing the scholarship

1. Continue artistic achievement by actively participating and or garnering a place or a commendation in at least regional, national or international art event;
2. Maintain a General Weighted Average (GWA) of 80% or higher with no failing grades; and
3. Arts scholars shall render their required forty (40) community service hours in activities directly related to arts, culture, and creative practice, including but not limited to arts workshops, performances, exhibits, cultural education activities, heritage promotion programs, and creative outreach initiatives organized or endorsed by the City Government of Batac, barangays, schools, cultural institutions, or accredited partner organizations. All such activities shall be approved, coordinated, and verified by the Office of the Mayor – Local Youth Development Section.
4. No service hours for elementary arts scholars.

IV. Amount of Grant

The beneficiary shall receive a Financial Assistance of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) per school year.
